## Format

The Annual Symposium on Chemometrics of the Dutch Chemometric Society aims at presenting the current state of the art in chemometric research in the Netherlands. It is meant as a stage for the different research groups to present their recent work. It is held every year in May except every 4<sup>th</sup> year when the International Chemometrics Research Meetings (ICRM) are held.

This time the symposium will focus on the application of chemometrics and multivariate data analysis to food-related topics. This theme will be approached from many different sides, with speakers from University and from the industry.
