

ACCOMMODATION

CSL has a block allocation at the Park Inn, York (<http://www.parkinn.com>) with a discounted rate of £79.00 B&B per night for the nights of 10th/11th/12th October 2006.

Reservations will be taken on a first come, first served basis, with the best rooms allocated first! You should therefore submit your confirmation form to the hotel as soon as possible.

The Park Inn is located in the centre of York, on the banks of the River Ouse. It has 200 guest rooms, the Waterfront Bar & Brasserie and the Regatta Lounge Bar. The hotel also has a fully-equipped Fitness Club with cardio-vascular resistance equipment.

CSL's block room allocation will be released on 25th August 2006 - bookings made after this time will be subject to availability and standard room rate.

TRANSPORT TO CSL
